Students **entering 4<sup>th</sup> grade** need to choose <u>two</u> books <u>from the list below</u> to read over the summer. After reading the books, the student should complete the book report form (see attached). Parents should sign the form which will be given to the fourth grade teacher on the **FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL**. The reports will be graded and will be the student's first **Language test grade.** Deduction of points will be made each day it is late. <u>Any student not completing the reports after one week will receive a zero</u>.

If your child completes this summer reading, he/she will be able to attend the Patriot Picnic on the assigned day during 1<sup>st</sup> quarter.
